## Celestix Updates

### › For those who have Celestix Devices:

- Celestix no longer has any BMC2500's available, replaced by 3500.
- The 3500 series is actually on an altogether new hardware platform for us called the X4. The 2500's were on our Scorpio-X platform which we have stopped selling. (EOL will be May 15th, 2013). So these boxes have newer/faster/better components which should increase performance. Additionally, the 3500's will have an updated version of our BMC image running on them.
- BMC 3500 - BMC BladeLogic Appliance
  - 1U Intel Core 2 Duo
  - 4GB RAM
  - 500GB hard drive
  - 6 x 100/1000 Ethernet ports
  - Linux Kernel 2.6. COSMOS 4.1 web UI for appliance configuration and one-button system recovery.
