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Issue discussion – Feb 2011

- › **HFCLI Patch - Issue ID: ISS03694383 - Request - : INC11071 : BBBCA --- Erro**
- › **Craig F – HFCLI.exe error**
 - I have been testing the new scan engine for Shavlik 'STAssessment_7.01\Bin\hfcli.exe'. We found that HFCLI is designed to expect a last backslash in the [InstallRoot]reg key string.
 - e.g. c:\WINDOWS\Microsoft.NET\Framework\
 - If the string is [empty] HFCLI pops up the attached error. Shavlik stated to me, they will create a fix and provide to BMC.

- › **Windows 7 issues**
 - Tuner death reported
 - Some reports of issues relating to power mgmt settings and sleep/suspend conditions.
 - potential Win7 call to discuss
 - Power management features do not map clearly to win7
 - Packages do not write to HKLM/SW/classes/
 - ISS03690695
