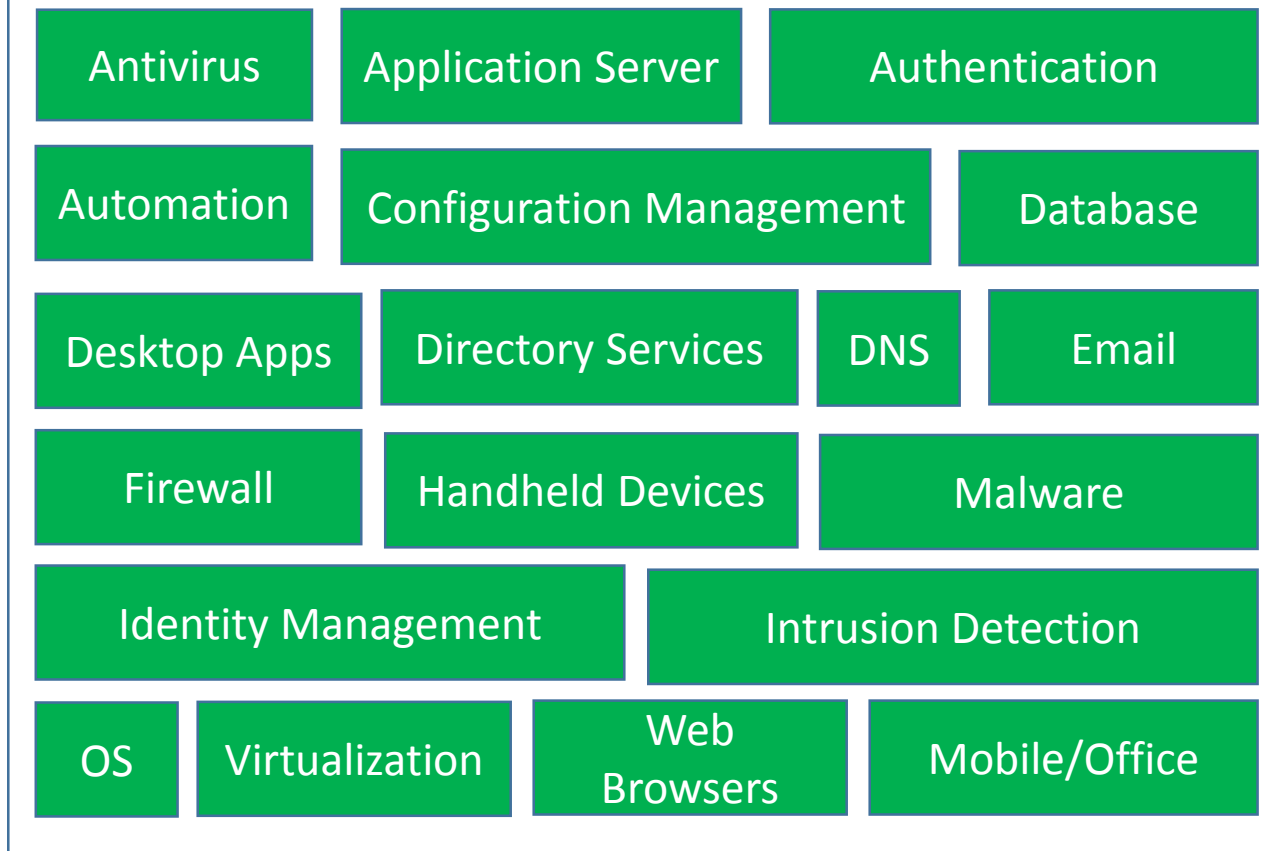

Marimba Security Management - Scanners

- **USGCB**
 - USGCB scanning program that enables you to monitor the USGCB compliance of your Windows computers against the benchmarks in Security Content Automation Protocol (SCAP) bundles.
 - By scheduling compliance scans against your endpoints, you can monitor the compliance of your Windows computers
- **Open SCAP**
 - A method and set of specific open XML standards that enable automated vulnerability management, configuration management, asset management, and compliance management.
 - By scheduling compliance scans against your endpoints, you can monitor the compliance of your Linux and Mac computers
- **Desktop Security**
 - helps the IT administrator to ensure the security of each and every desktop under their infrastructure
 - empowers the admin to closely monitor what all can be accessed and what all are restricted for the users and machines
- **Shavlik Patch Compliance**
 - Scans your machine to check if the end-points have the required patches applied, as per the metadata released by Shavlik every month
- **Other Scanners**
 - In addition to the scanners mentioned above, Marimba will also provide a way to use any other standard solutions in the market
 - Marimba core engine is capable of processing any security content assigned. This helps you to define any other scanners as well that can be used to compute the security compliance in the organization
