9.0.05.001 GA Announcement

- RTM on July 31, 2018
- Channels are available in Channel Store (**No Restrictions**)
- Key Focus Areas - Feature Enhancements, Stability and Platform Expansion

9.0.05.001 Features

- Infrastructure
 - Marimba IoT Connector
 - Windows 10 Migration support
 - MaMos Scripting & Workflow
 - Option to hide 'stop tuner' from LWTA
 - New command line option to clear Tx index and file cache
 - Option in admin tools to start-stop channels on multiple endpoints with arguments
 - OTA for Android and eLinux based devices
- Application Packager Enhancements
 - Option to create new folder to save pre & post snapshot content
 - New APIs for registry redirection
 - Support for using external Jars/Zips in classpath of package
- CMS Enhancements
 - Dual Directory Service Support
 - Option to control Dashboard
- Patch Management
 - Dashboard Enhancements
 - Addition of more Queries

9.0.05.001 Features (cont.)

- Discovery
 - Workflow enhancement to eliminate checksum dependency*
 - Notification about scanning status when scan is triggered through tuner icon menu options
 - Delete option added to all the plugin configuration pages to clean up the unnecessary URLs
 - Option to send email notification when plugin queue reaches a specified limit
 - Force endpoints to perform and send full scan at configured schedule/interval
 - New attribute in inventory that captures and retains the first scan time of the machine
- Policy Management
 - Option to backup policy definition files and compare them
 - New UI option to allow users to add all the packages or patch groups from the URL specified in policy manager
- Channel Store Enhancements

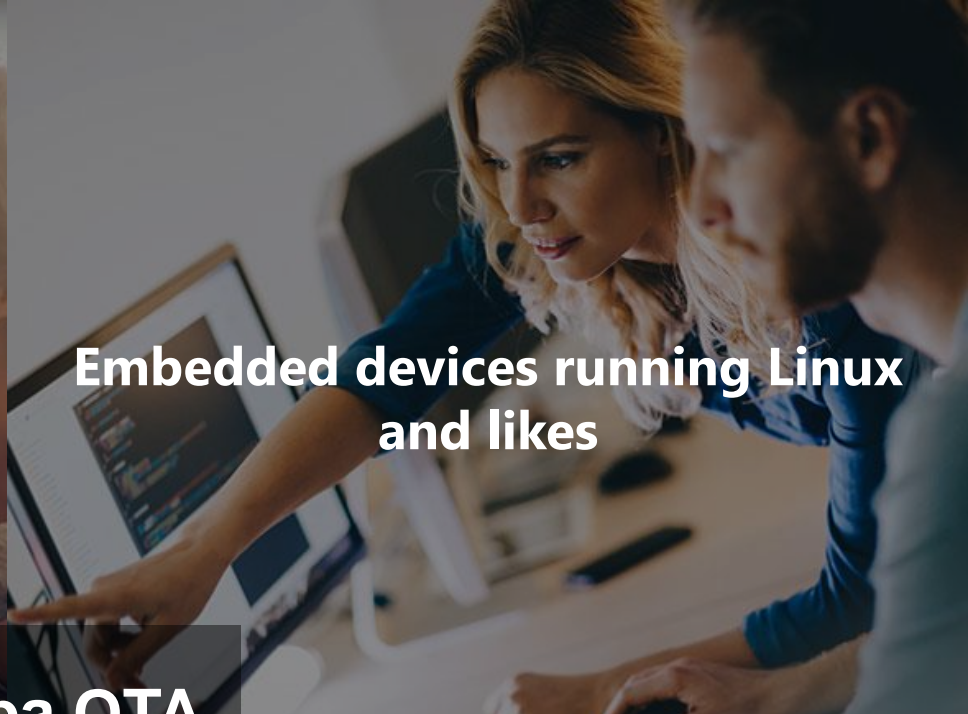

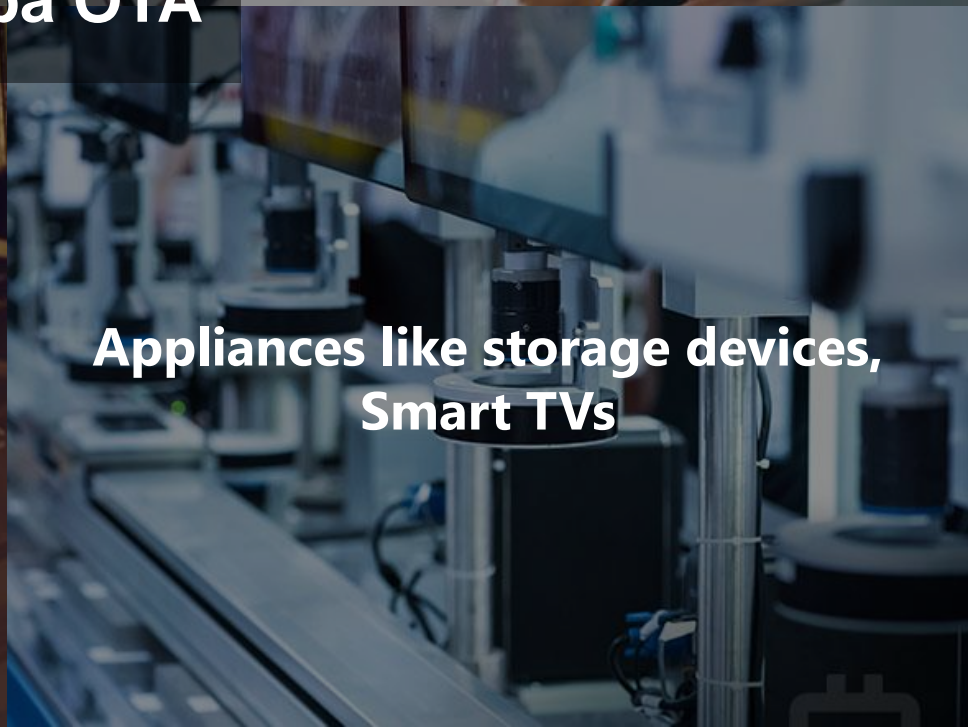
Android, iOS and Windows based devices

Marimba MDM

- **Current positioning**
 - Supports Android as a platform
 - Offers services like OTA, configuration and security management etc.
 - Supports eLinux based devices
 - Bezel, Verifone, Samsung Artik etc.
 - Offers full scale management including Clarinet and Logsight.
 - No Support for iOS yet
- **iOS Roadmap**
 - iOS v1 is scheduled for March 2019 Release
 - App management, Configuration management, Settings and User enablement
 - iOS v2 is scheduled for July 2019 Release
 - OTA, Provisioning, Device security
- IoT to follow quarterly release cycle
 - Support for connected devices would see a release every 3 months
 - Roadmap and release items are published at our website (www.marimba.com)
